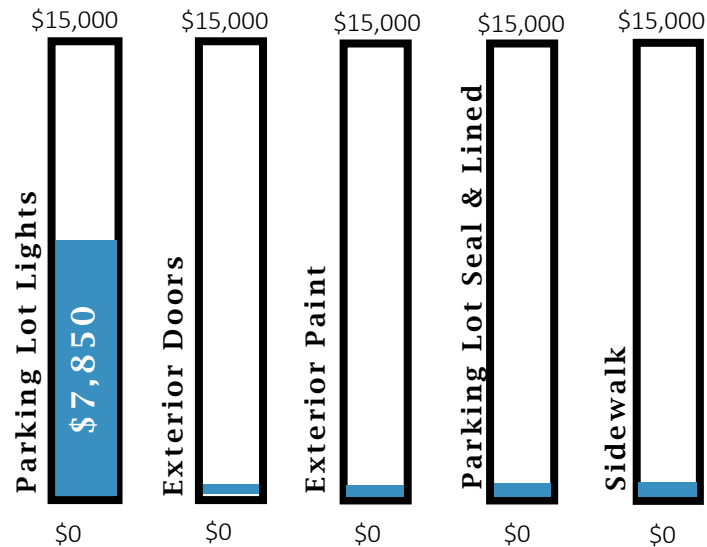


The work continues

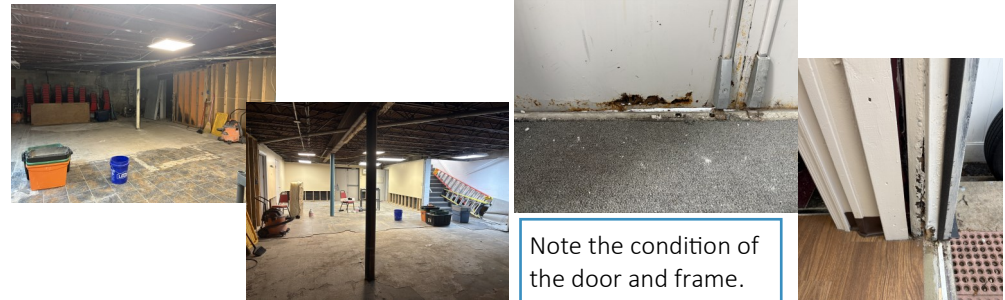
